

REPORT FINDS LADLI SCHEME IRRAGULARITIES

The much-touted scheme of Haryana government — Ladli — which was launched to improve the condition of girl child, has come under the cloud for all the wrong reasons. Serious irregularities have been found in the implementation of the scheme meant to help the girl child. The Asian center for human rights (ACHR) has talked about the irregularities in its report titled 'the state of female feticide in Haryana,' and has sought the intervention of the National Human Rights commission. In its report ACHR has said that the comptroller and auditor general of India and accountant general of Haryana have found irregularities of Rs 19.4 crore in the implementation of the Ladli scheme in four districts, namely, Jind, Karnal, Hisar and Rewari alone. The report further says that "₹10.95 crore were paid to 5,153 beneficiaries under Ladli social security allowance scheme without proper verification" in three districts of Haryana namely, Jind, Karnal and Hisar.
